RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is vitally aware that there are many elderly people residing in the Community of East Fork who are unable to provide for themselves nutritionally, and
- WHEREAS, personnel have been trained to prepare and serve one adequate meal, five days weekly, to these Senior Citizens, and
- WHEREAS, this Program has been an immea urable benefit to the elderly in the Whiteriver area.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes and directs that application be made for a Nutrition Project Award under Title VII of the Older American Act to provide five meals weekly for the elderly at the Community of East Fork.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on January 18, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
