RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware that Mr. Harry Cromwell, a non-Indian, owns and operates a vehicle repair shop at the site of the Fort Apache Timber Company, on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, ordinances of the White Mountain Apache Tribe provide for the licensing of traders and leasing of tribal land to non-Indians doing business on the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that Mr. Cromwell has neither a trader's license nor a business lease to conduct such business operations on the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the services to the Tribe, tribal departments and enterprises from the vehicle repair business conducted by Mr. Cromwell, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is appropriate to issue to Mr. Cromwell proper authorization to continue conducting business on the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed the terms of a business lease with Mr. Cromwell and finds that an annual lease with rental fees in the amount of \$600.00 per month is agreeable to both parties, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds that Mr. Cromwell has been in business as herein described since June 20, 1978.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Chairman and Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent to forthwith issue appropriate trader's licenses, assess licenses fees, and otherwise enforce Trader's licensing laws and regulations on the operation of a vehicle repair shop by Mr. Harry Cromwell on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation since June 20, 1978.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman shall execute a business lease, for and on behalf of the Tribe, with Mr. Cromwell, for one year terms beginning June 20, 1978, at the rental rate of \$600.00 per month, and under such other terms and conditions as deemed appropriate by the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on February 06, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 2 abst. 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
