RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested by the Apache Language Culture Program to officially recognize the Program's Language Committee, and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of Tribal Council sanctioning is that materials produced under the auspices of the committee can form the basis of an official written language for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has also been requested to authorize funding for committee per diem and mileage costs, and has considered such request, a copy of which is attached hereto.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby sanctions the Apache Language and Culture Program's Language Committee, for the purposes herein specified.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes that the Central Tribe Budget, Fiscal Year 1980/81 shall provide for funding of the Language Committee's per diem and mileage expenses of \$4,395.00.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
