

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs currently provides employment assistance through the Bureau's programs, and

WHEREAS, Public Law 93-638 authorizes the Department of the Interior to contract with Indian Tribes for bureau programs including the employment assistance program, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to undertake the responsibilities of operating such employment assistance under a 638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, beginning Fiscal Year, October 1, 1980, and

WHEREAS, the Health, Education & Welfare Committee recommends and endorses this action.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe authorizes and directs that a contract be entered into with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under Public Law 93-638 to provide total service for White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Employment Assistance functions (Division of Job Placement and training).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Tribal Education Department is authorized to negotiate the terms and conditions of said contract on behalf of the Tribe.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to complete this contract.


The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
