RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is painfully aware of the circumstances of a traffic accident in which a young tribal member, Fritz Walker, was critically injured and remains paralyzed, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested to provide assistance to such tribal member whose exceptional dilemma necessitates specialized construction of housing to meet his needs, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that this young man's dire misfortune deserves the assistance of the Tribe through all available resources, and
- WHEREAS, the tribal effort to pool all resources to provide proper housing for Fritz Walker can be adequately handled through the Tribal Work Experience Program.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the donation of the following items from the departments, enterprises or agencies as indicated:

Save the Children Federation Program: Siding and roofing.
Apache Development Enterprise: particle board, sheet rock.
Maintenance Department: electrical and plumbing materials.
White Mountain Recreation Enterprise: construction equipment available and a stove.
Fort Apache Timber Company: all lumber materials necessary.
Bureau of Indian Affairs: grading and gravel
Utility Authority and Indian
Health Service: septic tank, leech line, special shower equipment and bathroom fixtures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Work Experience Program is authorized and directed to obtain available blue prints for the construction herein authorized, to notify all departments, agencies or enterprises of the Council's directives herein, and to take all such further action as is necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution, subject to the approval of the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
