


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested to provide assistance to the Save the Children Federation Program for the construction of needed welfare homes, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has thoroughly reviewed and considered such request and the purposes of providing greatly needed house repair work to indigent families.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby directs the Fort Apache Timber Company to contribute lumber materials (economy grade) to the Save the Children Federation Program, as set forth on the attached itemized list.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
