RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Indian Agency, is acting so as to maintain any Bureau housing or buildings on the Reservation only within designated Bureau compounds, and
- WHEREAS, presently, Bureau of Indian Affairs' quaters #65 and 67 (formerly the Forestry and Roads buildings) and parcel of land in Whiteriver are located outside of the Agency compound, and the Bureau desires to transfer ownership of said quarters to the Tribe which is in extreme need of such structures.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby accepts the transfer of Bureau of Indian Affairs quarters Nos. 65 and 67 and parcel of land to the ownership and possession of the Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized or execute any and all documents as may be necessary to effectuate said transfer.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
