# RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Sunrise Resort Complex Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Sunrise Enterprise has presented a proposed capital construction budget for fiscal year 1980-81 of approximately \$400,000.00, which budget has been approved by the Tribal Finance Committee for subsequent action by the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Economic Development Administration (EDA) has indicated an interest in matching a Tribal capital investment of approximately \$460,000.00 with an equal amount (for a total of \$919,000.00) in order to finance badly needed construction and renocation projects for the Sunrise Enterprise, as set forth in the attached exhibit, and
- WHEREAS, the OEDP Committee, after detailed review of such capital investment budget, recommends these proposed projects for approval by the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves a Sunrise Resort Complex Enterprise budget as described above, authorizing the expenditure of up to \$460,000.00 from Enterprise profits, for the purpose of matching an equal amount of Economic Development Administration funds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to negotiate grant funding from EDA and to take all such other actions as are required to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on March 05, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of  $\frac{8}{100}$  for and  $\frac{1}{100}$  against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i & k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
