- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby nominates Mr. Tom Fredericks for appointment to the position of Assistant Secretary of Interior, Indian Affairs and recommends his appointment by the Secretary of the Interior in the best interests of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on March 05, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
