RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to apply for funds in the amount of \$182,506.00 for the Bilingual/Bicultural Program under Part B., Title IV of the Indian Education Act, to improve educational opportunities for Indian children by providing educational services that are not available in sufficient quantity or quality, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Elementary schools of Cedar Creek and Cibecue have agreed to implement this demonstration project to serve as a model Bilingual/Bicultural program for all reservation schools.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to submit a proposal to enter into a contract with the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, Office of Indian Education according to the guidelines under Part B., Title IV of the Indian Education Act as published in the Federal Register Vol. 44, No. 127, Friday, June 29, 1979, for the purposes hereinabove described.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consumate this contractual agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on March 05, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
