RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the position of Secretary to the Tribal Council is one of the several tribal employment positions which are appointive by the Tribal Council and subject to such rates at compensation as the Tribal Council may from time to time establish, and
- WHEREAS, the salary for such position has not been reviewed or changed by the Council in many years, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the need to increase the salary for such position in order to bring it into line with the status, duties and obligations involved in such a position.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes a new salary rate for the position of Secretary to the Tribal Council in the amount of \$18,000.00 per annum, effective by 1980-1981.

The foregoing resolution was on March 18, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
