

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has reviewed and considered the Constitution and By-Laws of the Cibecue Day School local school board as presented to the Council by Cibecue Community leaders, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that such constitution is necessary for the orderly function of all school board activities, and

WHEREAS, it is generally acknowledged that the Tribal Council should have ultimate approval authority in local school board matters.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Cibecue Day School Local Board Constitution and By-Laws, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, subject to written acknowledgement of the Tribal Council authority within such constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
