
BE IT RESOLVED that the attached budget of Apache Youth is approved.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds to initiate these programs be appropriated as needed by the Central Accounting Office from the Land Claims Funds on deposit with the United States Government in order to fund the Apache Youth Program in the above communities.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
