FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Finance Committee of the Tribal Council recommends the use of the Revenue Sharing funds in the amount of \$16,805.00 on behalf of the Carrizo and Cedar Creek Communities, and


WHEREAS, this use of Revenue Sharing Funds shall enhance the progress of such communities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Revenue Sharing funds be disbursed in the following areas:

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
