

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has contracted with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under Public Law 93-638 for various programs, and

WHEREAS, each year the Bureau of Indian Affairs requires a resolution to recontract, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe does not foresee discontinuing any of such contract grants.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Tribe reapplies for the following contracts and grants for Fiscal Year 1980, and for each year thereafter:

1. On-going Child Welfare
2. Johnson O'Malley
3. Judicial Service
4. Community Education
5. Tribal Work Experience
6. Custodial Care for the Elderly
7. Law Enforcement and detention
8. Home Improvement
9. Government Improvement

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents requested to consummate any of these contracts and grants.


