RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that the Whiteriver Police Department operations are funded in part by a Law and Order Contract through the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that it is necessary to modify such contract for Fiscal Year 1980 so as to increase funding in the amount of \$60,000.00, and
- WHEREAS, such funding provides for the operation of the Police Department by the Tribe and is therefore crucial to tribal governmental operations.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the modification of the Tribe's Law and Order contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, for operations of the Whiteriver Police Department Fiscal Year 1980, in the amount of \$60,000.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Chairman is authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to carry out the purpose of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
