

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Education Department operates a summer youth program at the Tribe's Youth Camps on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised of increased expenses in the operation of such youth camps including the necessity for camp facility repairs and vehicle operation expenses, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Tribe to support any tribal programs directed at young people of the tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finds it appropriate to donate lumber materials from Fort Apache Timber Company to assist in making the necessary camp facility repairs, and
- WHEREAS, the Enterprise Manager for the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, which also uses such camp facilities, shall contribute the sum of \$3,000.00 to the Education Department for assistance in making such facility repairs to the camp facilities, and
- WHEREAS, the Education Department therefore still requires approximately \$2,000.00 for vehicle operation expenses in the operations of its youth program in the upcoming summer.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$2,000.00 from Central Tribe Contingency Account, Fiscal Year 1980-1981 budget, for the purposes of providing additionally needed funds to the Tribal Education Department for vehicle operation and use in the summer youth camp program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes the donation of lumber to the Tribal Education Department necessary for making repairs to camp facilities as hereinabove described.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
