

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council, by Resolution No. 78-201, approved the participation of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the Section 208 Water Quality Management Planning program of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA); and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe was subsequently designated by the EPA as a Water Quality Management Agency and was approved by EPA for a grant of \$50,000 to fund the development of a comprehensive Water Quality Management Plan for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires tribal participation in the 208 Water Quality Management Planning program of EPA for the purpose of improving all health conditions related thereto for tribal members on the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further desires said participation for the purpose of establishing Tribal Water Management prerogatives which are preclusive of federal water quality regulation and preemptive of any possible state regulatory intrusion.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 78-201 and the participation of the Tribe in the Section 208 Water Quality Management Planning Program of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for the purposes herein above described.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out this resolution and to take such actions as may be necessary to develop the Tribal Water Quality Management Plan herein described.


The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
