RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the White Mountain Apache Roads and Construction Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, among its purposes, the Enterprise is directed to produce income to the Tribe from road construction or other related projects; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that some BIA construction projects, within the purpose and capability of the Enterprise, may be available for bidding by the Tribe through its Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interests of the Tribe to direct its Enterprise to submit appropriate bids to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for all projects within its purpose and capability.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby directs and authorizes the bidding
 by the Tribe, through its Roads and Construction Enterprise, of all Bureau of Indian Affairs projects which
 serve the Enterprise's purposes and capability.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
