

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe held a regular Council meeting on May 7 and 8, 1980, and therein enacted Resolution Nos. 80-121 through 80-145; and

WHEREAS, the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe require presentation of Council resolutions which require BIA approval, to the Agency Superintendent within ten days of enactment; and

WHEREAS, the Resolutions passed by the Council on May 7 and 8, 1980, were not presented to the Agency Superintendent within ten days by reason that they are not, to-date duly signed by the Secretary of the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires thereby to remove any doubt or objection to the efficacy of any of any of such resolutions.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms each and every resolution previously enacted at its regular meeting on May 7 and 8, 1980, as if duly passed on this date, and directed that all of same be timely presented to the Agency Superintendent as appropriate by law.


The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
