

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe annually establishes a "day-light savings" business-hours schedule for the summer months of such year;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council considers such action in the perspective of the interests of the tribal employees as well as of proper tribal business operations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes business hours from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (one hour lunch break) for all departments and branches of the Central Tribe, and for such tribal enterprises as may choose to also use such schedule.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this directive is effective beginning at 7:30 a.m. on May 28, 1980, and ending at 4:30 p.m. on September 1, 1980.


The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
