RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware of the crisis situation in the Community of McNary caused by the reduction in lumber mill operations there, and
- WHEREAS, the McNary Community has presented its request to the Council for assistance in a community project, which would include the renovation and addition to the existing Community Building and the creation of a recreation field, and
- WHEREAS, the Council is further advised that the purposes of this community project are to provide recreation activities for all age groups in the community, to provide for better communication with tribal leaders, and to provide open facilities for community members for any community activities, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that such community project will serve the thirty (30) tribal families now residing in the McNary Community, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it in the best interests of such tribal members that assistance be provided in supporting the McNary Community Project and the continued existence of the McNary Community itself, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been presented with a proposed cost estimate in the amount of \$20,000.00 for the foregoing purposes, a copy of which proposed budget is attached hereto.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the expenditure of not more than \$20,000.00 from Revenue Sharing funds, for the purpose of the renovation of the McNary Community Building and such other community activities as is presented by the proposed budget for such project, a copy of which is attached hereto.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
