

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has previously acted to amend the Plan of Operations for the Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs of the Phoenix Area Office has notified the Tribe that it disapproves said Plan of Operations as enacted by the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has been further advised of appeal procedures for the purpose of challenging said Bureau decision, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed its reasons and bases for amending the Fort Apache Timber Company Plan of Operations and herein further supports said reasons.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs its Tribal Legal Department to take all action to appropriately appeal or otherwise challenge the action of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Phoenix Area Office, in disapproving the Plan of Operations for its Fort Apache Timber Company as enacted by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
