

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Road Maintenance Budget for 1980 was cut \$23,000.00, and
- WHEREAS, the flood damage for 1980 was done with maintenance funds, and
- WHEREAS, the cost of fuel has greatly increased, and
- WHEREAS, the operations of the repair shop was covered with maintenance funds, and
- WHEREAS, additional funds are needed to keep the three (3) heavy equipment operators on until the new fiscal year begins October 1, 1980, and
- WHEREAS, Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) is required for their salaries for six (6) pay periods beginning July 1, 1980 through September 30, 1980, and
- WHEREAS, the employes are Virgil Dehose, Charles Malone, Sr., and Harry Stover, Jr., and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Roads Maintenance Budget for 1981 has sufficient funds to rehire all three (3) individuals.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby funds the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads \$15,000.00 for salaries as hereinabove described.


The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
