

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is informed that the Zuni Archaeology Program has made application for a permit under the Federal Antiquities Act, 16 U.S.C. 431-433; and
- WHEREAS, the Zuni Archaeology Program is a part of the Pueblo of Zuni Tribal Government; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of the permit application is to make archeological investigations, including surveying collections and limited testing on various Indian Reservation, including parts of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, such archeological investigations will under-take to research places and objects of traditional, religious and scientific importance to the Zuni Tribal Government in its efforts to study and manage all traditional or pre-historic cultural resources of the Pueblo; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe supports the efforts of all Indian Tribes to preserve their heritage and culture.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the issuance of a permit under the Federal Antiquities Act, 16 U.S.C. 431-433, to the Pueblo of Zuni, Zuni Archaeology Program, pursuant to their application for service, to undertake archaeological investigations with the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out all this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of The White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
