

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by Mr. Bert Hinton, a tribal member, to grant him land in East Fork, near Fort Apache; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the land requested was previously authorized to Mr. Hinton, but inadvertently not recorded in Council minutes; and

WHEREAS, the land request needs to be surveyed by proper identification of the assignment to Mr. Hinton.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs and authorizes the assignment to Mr. Bert Hinton, a tribal member, of land in East Fork near Fort Apache, as shall hereafter be surveyed and specifically identified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Land Coordinator is authorized and directed to undertake the surveying of the land assigned to Mr. Bert Hinton by this resolution, and to record the identified thereof as is appropriate.


The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 6 for, 0 against and 2 abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
