

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is eligible for Tribal Government Improvement Grant, through the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the rules governing such funds, the Tribal Council is bound to establish priorities on the expenditure of such monies; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and discussed the types of tribal projects which may be funded from this grant; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised of the estimated of several of such projects which can be funded from this grant; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that a recording system for Tribal Council meetings is needed and that renovation and heating equipment are needed to use the old Indian Health Service facilities for tribal operations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes priorities for expenditures of 1980 Tribal Government Improvement Grant funding as follows:

Tribal Council Recording System.	\$ 8,000.00
Renovation of old I.H.S. facilities for tribal office space.	40,000.00
The purchase and installation of heating equipment in the old I.H.S. facilities for tribal use.	40,000.00


The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
