

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by the Canyon Day Community for an allocation of \$10,000.00 from Revenue Sharing funds, if available; and


WHEREAS, the Community proposes to use such funds to purchase and install a waterline to the Canyon Day Community Rodeo Grounds; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the purpose of Revenue Sharing funds is for community improvement projects such as the one proposed by Canyon Day.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the expenditure of \$10,000.00 from Revenue Sharing funds for the purpose of purchasing and installing the above described waterline for the Canyon Day Community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant herein authorized by the Tribal Council is conditioned upon the availability of said funds from Revenue Sharing monies and subject to the review and approval of same by the Finance Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
