FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that there is a vacancy in the position of Associate Tribal Court Judge; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is responsible for filling such position by appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously caused this position to be advertised; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and discussed the four submitted applications for this position; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has voted by secret ballot on the eligible candidates.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Kay Lewis, a tribal member, as Associate Judge of the Tribal Court of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a four-year term beginning on the date his oath of office is administered.



Subject: Tribal Resolution No. 80-211

Resolution No. 80-211 reaffirms the policy of the Tribe to prohibit woodcutting by non-Tribal members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation. This prohibition specifically includes the termination of using tribal members, and the privileges of tribal members to undertake woodcutting for or on behalf of such non-members in accordance with resolution.

The resolution was adopted on July 9, 1980, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution. Under this authority the resolution is not subject to review or approval.
