RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Chris Condit, of Pinetop, Arizona, and a graduate student at the University of New Mexico, has requested permission from the White Mountain Apache Tribe to map the geology and study the volcanic stratigraphy on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, said proposed mapping and study would occur on the northern and eastern portion of the Reservation east of State Highway 73 and 173, and including the area of volcanic rocks south of the northern boundary of the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe is interested in increasing the amount of reliable information, under its own auspices, on the physical resources of the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, such reliable information may prove useful to the Tribe in developing and defending its natural resources.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Mr. Chris Condit to conduct the proposed geologic mapping and study of the volcanic stratigraphy on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, under the following stipulations and conditions:
 - 1) His work is to be done in accordance with the highest standards of the geologic profession.

All data he generates from this project including all maps, field notes, and reports, shall be kept confidential and shall not be released to any University, the U. S. Geological Survey, or to any government agencies, or to other persons without the specific permission of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

He shall submit for review, all such maps, notes, and reports to the Tribe's technical representative, Dr. Charles S. Robinson, Geologic Consultant, for their presentation and recommendation to the Tribal Council before any release of such items or information.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
