FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe sat in session on June 20th and July 8 and 9, 1980, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council enacted Resolutions No. 80-185 through 80-214 during said council meetings, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further finalized Ordinance No. 113 and took other actions recorded in the council minutes for said meetings, respectively, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that said resolutions, ordinance, and meeting minutes were not delivered to the Bureau of Indian Affairs within ten (10) days of the council meeting dates, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to remove any doubt as to the effectiveness of all such council actions from these meetings.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby re-affirms Resolutions No. 80-185 through 80-214, Ordinance No. 113, and all other actions taken by the Tribal Council at its meeting on June 20th and July 8 and 9, 1980.


