

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that many Cibecue homes need indoor bathroom facilities for the benefit of the health and improvement of Cibecue residents, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised of a proposal to make bathroom additions to twenty-seven (27) homes in Cibecue through the joint effort of the Indian Health Service, the Tribal Work Experience Program and the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, such proposal is based upon an estimated cost of \$500.00 per house for a 6' x 4' add-on bathroom to each home, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that Indian Health Service will provide the necessary plumbing facilities for this purpose, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested to provide all the lumber necessary for the construction of these additions, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that this project is in the best interest of the needy people in the community of Cibecue who will be served by it.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the tribe's contribution of hog lumber from its Fort Apache Timber Company, sufficient for the addition of 6' x 4' bathrooms for twenty-seven (27) houses in the community of Cibecue, in cooperation with the Indian Health Service and the Tribal Work Experience Program plan for such project as hereinabove described.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Work Experience Program is hereby authorized to act for and on behalf of the tribe in fulfilling the purposes of this Resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
