

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Administration for Native Americans Office has asked the Tribal Council to purchase a car to be leased through the Tribe to the ANA Program for distribution of food stamps on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to support this request contingent on approval of money for this purpose by the Washington ANA Office through appropriate contract modification.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that subsequent to approval of funds for the lease of the automobile to the ANA Program, the Chairman's Office is authorized and directed to purchase an automobile to be leased to the ANA Program for the purposes of the food stamp distribution; provided that the purchase amount of the automobile may not exceed \$7,800.00.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consummate this purchase and lease agreement, and to subsequently arrange the lease of the automobile to ANA Program every year thereafter.


The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
