RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the State of Arizona, Department of Economic Security, has offered the White Mountain Apache Tribe the option of distributing food stamps through the Administration for Native Americans Office, rather than by direct mailing to post office boxes, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed the advantages of this food stamp delivery system.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is authorized and directed to enter into a contract of agreement between the State of Arizona, Department of Economic Security, and the White Mountain Apache Tribe for distribution of food stamps through the Administration for Native Americans Office; provided that compensation for this service, as agreed between the parties, will be \$833.33 per month as a fixed rate paid to the White Mountain Apache Tribe by the State of Arizona for providing this service.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that acceptance of this contract by the White Mountain Apache Tribe is contingent on approval by the Washington Administration for Native Americans Office of a contract modification permitting the White Mountain Apache Tribe's ANA Office to use funds from their annual grant for lease of an automobile to be used in providing delivery of food stamps to communities on the Reservation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, subject to the above contingency, the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents required to consumate this contractual agreement, and to subsequently recontract every year thereafter.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
