## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested for authorization for the operation of a power saw business by Alvino Hawkins and Joaquin Kessay, tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, these tribal members propose to use available space in the "Old Barber Shop" near the Apache Service Station, and
- WHEREAS, such building is owned by the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the use of such space for this purpose is appropriate.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Alvino Hawkins and Joaquin Kessay to use the available space above-described, and to operate on such premises, a power saw repair business.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to negotiate and agree upon the terms and conditions for rental use of the tribal space involved for the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
