## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has great and sincere interest in improving, developing, coordinating and strengthening health services, both physically and mentally, on the Reservation; and in more fully utilizing the potential of our Apache Tribal Guidance Center personnel, their skills and their experience, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that the developmentally disabled person has a right to proper medical care and physical therapy, and to such education, training, rehabilitation and guidance as will enable him to develop his ability and maximum potential, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe realizes that the developmentally disabled have a right to protection from exploitation, abuse, and degrading treatment and that the developmentally disabled person has to the maximum degree of feasibility the same rights as other human beings, and
- WHEREAS, it has become necessary and required by law for the Arizona

  Department of Economic Security, Division of Developmental Disabilities
  to have an approved intergovernmental agreement with the White Mountain
  Apache Tribe when entering into service contracts with the Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Department of Economic Security, Division of Developmental Disabilities to provide Social Development services to three developmentally disabled adults for the period October 1, 1980 through June 30, 1981, and that this agreement allows for amendments to the contract during the contract period.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby empowered and authorized to exercise the perogative contemplated by ARS 11-951 through 11-954 for intergovernmental agreements on services to the developmentally disabled, and to sign any and all documents pertaining to direct services contracts.

The foregoing resolution was on August 26, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
