

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested to provide financial assistance to Matthew Nozie, a tribal member, for the purpose of providing aviation pilot training to him, and

WHEREAS, the Council is advised that \$1500.00 is necessary for Matthew Nozie to complete his private pilot's license training, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that such license is a prerequisite to a VA subsidy for advanced pilot training planned by said tribal member, and


WHEREAS, this requested funding is intended to serve as the foundation for such tribal member to obtain full commercial pilot certifications, through VA funding, of all necessary training, and to ultimately provide the Tribe with access to a tribal member pilot for tribal operations.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby grant to Matthew Nozie, the sum of \$1500.00, as and for the purposes herein specified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs the expenditure of such sum from the contingency fund of the Central Tribe Budget, Fiscal Year 1980-81.

The foregoing resolution was on August 26, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
