

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has provided by ordinance for the Council's appointment of the Chief Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised and aware the current elective term of the Chief Judge shall expire in April, 1980, leaving a vacancy for appointment by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the advice of the Law and Order Committee that consideration of filling such vacancy should be made forthwith, in order to avoid severe disruption in the Tribal Judicial System.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby (directs the Law and Order Committee, through the Tribal Personnel Department, to take all necessary and proper action to advertise the ensuing vacant position of Chief Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court, and to present all applications and information to the Tribal Council for timely council action.


The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
