

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that it is the duty of the United States Public Health Service to install required sanitary facilities to serve the Indian Homes on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Cibecue Regional sewage lagoon proposed by PHS/IHS is of the required nature, a copy of which locations is attached hereto, and by this reference incorporated herein, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council directs that the Indian Health Service avoid construction of these facilities on any tribal ceremonial or sacred ground within the designated sites.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the United States Public Health Service plans to construct the sewage lagoon as hereinabove designated.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
