## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN PESSENATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe, through the Apache Broadcasting Corporation Board of Directors, has been in the process of developing an FM non-commercial Radio Station to provide reservation-wide radio service to tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, preliminary work has been prepared and it is now necessary to have the future studio site and/or the Mass Media Communications Center identified.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the assignment and description of land as follows:

Location of land involved is in the Commercial Shopping Center Complex, immediately behind and west of the Post Office Building, and south of the Bowling Alley on a rise covering an area of land three hundred square feet (300' x 300').

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Land Coordinator is authorized and directed to undertake the surveying of land as described and approved by the Governing Body to the Apache Broadcasting Corporation Board of Directors and to record the description of the assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on September 11, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
