

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Northern Arizona University, Department of Anthropology has submitted application to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a permit under the Federal Antiquities Act, 16 U.S.C. 431-433, and


WHEREAS, stated purposes of the permit are to conduct archaeological clearance surveys, limited testing programs to assess the extent and/or significance of cultural remains, to make recommendations concerning mitigation of threatened remains, and to conduct archaeological research, including surveys, collection, and testing of selected areas and sites within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, to be specifically defined as necessary, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered said application by Northern Arizona University, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Tribe that the application be approved, subject to notice to the Tribe and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fort Apache Indian Agency of specific projects, as arises, covered by the permit herein requested.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants and consents to the issuance of Antiquities Permit under Federal Antiquities Act, Department of Anthropology, for the purposes hereinabove described; provided that the Tribal Council specifically requires that any and all requests to the Northern Arizona University for specific project investigation under this permit be subject to notice to the Tribe, through the Tribal Chairman's Office, and to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, through the Superintendent's Office, Fort Apache Indian Agency.


The foregoing resolution was on September 11, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
