

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that the Tribal Equipment and Roads Department needs two trucks, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further informed that its Tribal Work Experience Program and Tribal Hauling Program each have used vehicles which could be transferred for use by the Tribal Equipment and Roads Department, in exchange for the purchase of a new truck for the Tribal Work Experience Program and Tribal Hauling Program, respectively, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that the cost of new two-ton trucks is approximately \$11,000.00 each, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council reviewed and considered the proposed transfer and purchase of new vehicles and finds the proposal to be in the best interest of any department affected.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs the transfer of designated used trucks from Tribal Hauling Program and Tribal Work Experience Program to the Tribal Equipment and Roads Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes and directs the purchase of two (2) new trucks, one for Tribal Work Experience Program and Tribal Hauling Program each, not to exceed \$22,000.00 total.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Central Tribal Business Office is authorized and directed to appropriate said funds by an amendment to the Central Tribal Budget, Fiscal Year 1980-1981.


