

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the University of Arizona, School of Renewable Natural Resources, has requested permission of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to conduct studies of prescribed burn on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the purpose of this study is to test public perception of scenic quality and recreational acceptability of Ponderosa forest, and to construct a public education instrument that could be used to inform the public of effects of fire, and
- WHEREAS, as part of the study, University of Arizona requests permission to take color-slides of Ponderosa forest areas within the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that the reservation has a long history of prescribed burning plans with records and dates of the burns, and
- WHEREAS, this study is intended to take place during the months of September and October, 1980, and
- WHEREAS, a final report of this study may provide the Tribe with a means for communicating the objectives and results of prescribe fires to the public and gain greater public support for the Reservation Fire Management Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the University of Arizona, School of Renewable Natural Resources, to conduct a study of prescribed fires on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, during the months of September and October, 1980.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that copies of the project report and any other publications which results from this research be provided to the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Fort Apache Indian Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs.


