

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware that the Reservation boundary is being fenced, including at its boundary which borders the Pinetop-Lakeside area off the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that such boundary fencing will terminate public access through the Reservation at such location, including access to several private homes contiguous to the Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously determined that its boundary fencing project is necessary to deter further cattle rustling and other loss of cattle; unauthorized trespass with vehicles and damage to lands or injury to wildlife facilitated by such trespass; and to up-date the accuracy of the Reservation boundary and markings thereof in accordance with the current survey, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by several off-reservation residents to abate its fencing on the Rim Road for a period of sixty (60) days in order that they may use Reservation roads as access while they obtain an alternative access route to their off-reservation residences, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that such off-reservation residents are currently negotiating for access through other off-reservation private land, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it may abate boundary fencing at the Rim Road for a sixty-day period, by finishing the fencing in adjoining areas during such time.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the abatement of Reservation boundary fencing at the Rim Road border with off-reservation lands, as described in the map presented and attached hereto, for a period of sixty (60) days from the date hereof.

The foregoing resolution was on October 01, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f & i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

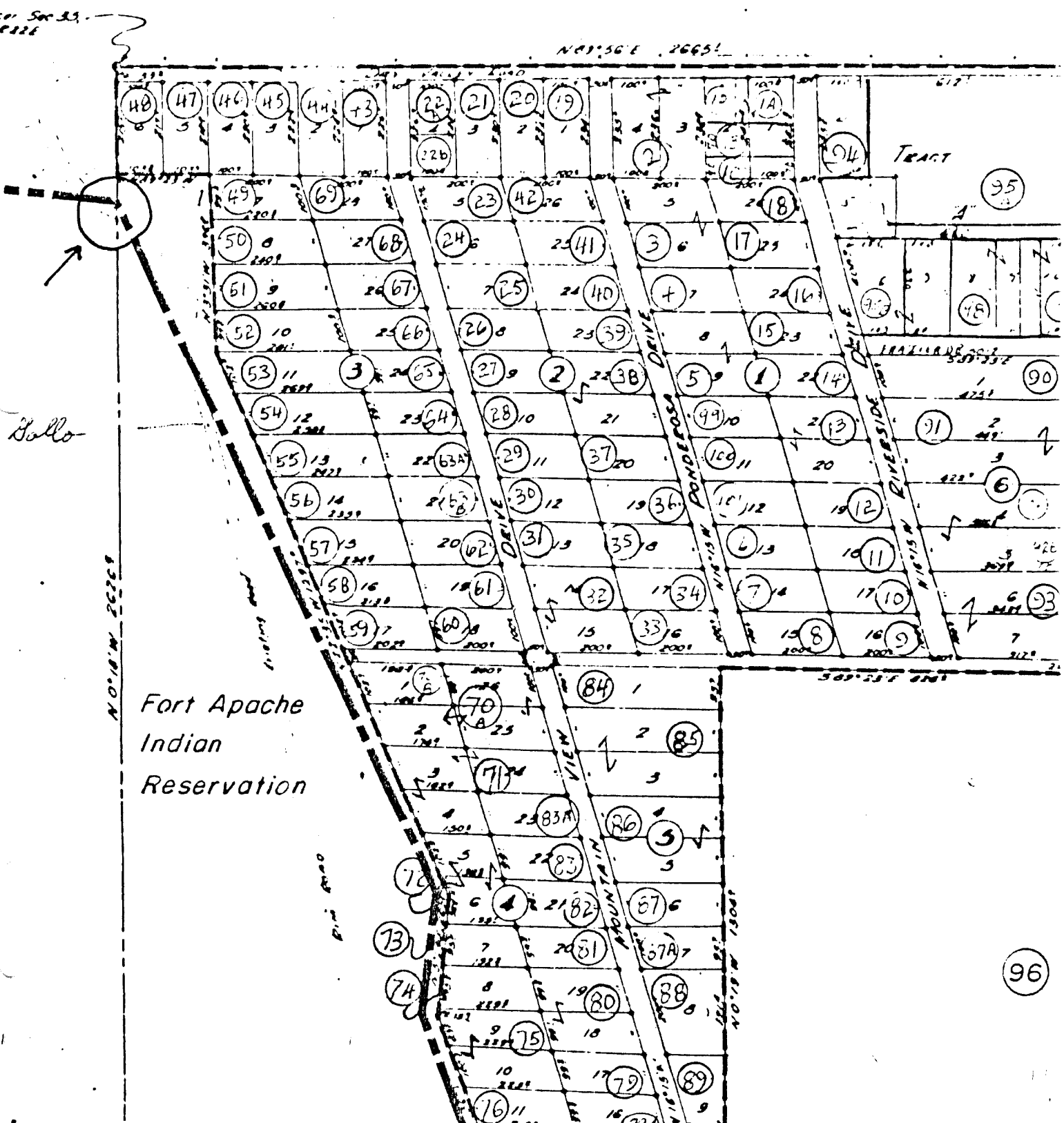
