WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Tribe has been invited by U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to submit a preapplication for Fiscal Year 1981 funding of Priority Tribal community development projects under the HUD Community Development Block Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Overall Economic Development Program Committee has solicited public participation in the selection of priority projects, and has evaluated and recommended the following projects for approval by the Council (listed in order of priority):

1.	Building for FM Radio Station	\$165,000.00
2.	Industrial Park Building for GSA Tenant (BIA)	\$250,000.00
3.	Paving Parking Area at new Recreation Building	\$125,000.00
	TOTAL GRANT REQUEST	\$540,000.00

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves the above projects and authorizes the Tribal Chairman to proceed with the necessary negotiations and to take such other actions as are required to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on October 01, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
