

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been notified that the U. S. Fish & Wildlife Service has placed Virgil Hinton, a tribal member, on a thirty-one-day "furlough" status, without pay, due to funding problems, and

WHEREAS, the Fish & Wildlife Service has requested that the Tribe fund position, for said period, at \$5.31 per hour in order to continue Mr. Hinton's employment, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered this request, and finds it appropriate to fund this position as requested through the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise which is responsible for game and fish matters on the Reservation.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the payment of salary to Mr. Virgil Hinton, a tribal member employed by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, at the rate of \$5.31 per hour during his thirty-one-day furlough as herein described.


The foregoing resolution was on October 01, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
