

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is informed that there is no water line to the residence of Eldon Declay in East Fork, and

WHEREAS, the Declay family is suffering substantial hardship without any water line to their residence, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Utility Authority is the tribal entity with authority and responsibility for water line installation.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Utility Authority to give top priority to the installation of the needed water line to the family residence of Eldon Declay at East Fork.


The foregoing resolution was on October 01, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
