## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has heretofore granted authorization for the operation of a private business on the Reservation by Alvino Hawkins, a tribal member, and
- WHEREAS, such business is intended to be a power tools sales and repair shop, and
- WHEREAS, such tribal member has applied to the Land Board for a business land assignment site on which to operate, and the Land Board has surveyed and approved a designated site for these purposes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants to Alvino Hawkins a business land assignment site, a description of which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, and for the purposes hereinabove described.

The foregoing resolution was on October 01, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
