

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Mrs. Mary Walker, a tribal member has presented to the Tribal Council her request for new housing, including adequated bathroom facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is informed that her current residence has been destroyed by vandalism and in any event did not have indoor plumbing nor provide proper shelter for her; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that Mrs. Mary Walker is in tremendous and immediate need of adequate housing.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs that Mrs. Mary Walker be placed on current housing application lists for housing assistance from any of the housing programs on the Reservation, as appropriate.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
