


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, within the past year the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented with an enrollment application of Lynn Martha Hitt, who had taken the name of "Sha Chual Declay", and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council subsequently referred said application to the Enrollment Committee for processing, and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reported its activities regarding this application, to the Tribal Council and recommended investigation of the enrollment request; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered the findings of the investigation conducted in this matter and;
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the recommendation of the Enrollment Committee to deny the enrollment of the applicant.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby denies the enrollment request of Ms. Martha Lynn Hitt a/k/a Sha Chual Declay.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1980, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
